Thailand Medical Visa Requirements

- 1. An Appointment Letter from a health care professional in Thailand.
- 2. A Referral Letter from a local doctor, including all recent medical records.
- 3. Sponsorship Letter, Bank Statement, and Solvency Certificate for attendants.
- 4. Duly filled and signed Visa Application Form.
- 5. Original passport with 6 months of validity beyond the estimated Thailand travel expiry date and with at least two blank pages (with the previous passport(s) if any).
- 6. 1 set of passport photocopies 1 to 5 and (correction page, Thai Visa page, Renewal page if any).
- 7. Sponsorship letter of the first applicant.
- 8. If self-funded service holders, Bank statements for the last 6 months (with a minimum closing balance of BDT 80,000 per person and 150,000 per family).

For Multiple Tourist Entry Visa (METV), Bank Statement for the last 6 months (with a minimum closing balance of BDT 5,00,000 per person and 10,00,000 per family).

Bank Solvency Certificate.

Or, If organization-funded service holders, Company Bank Statement, Bank Solvency Certificate, and Company Trade License.

- 9. For service holders, Salary Certificate, Pay Slip, or Salary Bank Statement.
- 10. Visa Request Letter.
- 11. No Objection Certificate (NOC) for private service holders.

Or, GO copy for govt. service holders.

Or, 1 photocopy of the Trade License with English translated original Notary copy (if the applicant's name is mentioned on the license) and Company Pad for businessmen.

Or, 1 photocopy of the Student ID card for students.

- 12. 2 recent passport-sized color photographs (3.5 cm x 4.5 cm) with a white background on mate paper.
- 13. For the spouse, 1 copy of the Marriage Certificate if the spouse's name is not mentioned on both passports.
- 14. 1 photocopy of any utility bill (WASA Bill, Electricity Bill, Gas Bill, Telephone Bill).

- 15. 1 photocopy of NID, or Birth Certificate.
- 16. 2-dose Covid vaccination certificate (3-dose if Chinese vaccines).
- 17. A confirmed return air ticket.
